All his life he's been told that his time would come: there would be recognition for his amazing skill and dedication. It hasn't happened yet and he's in his 70s!

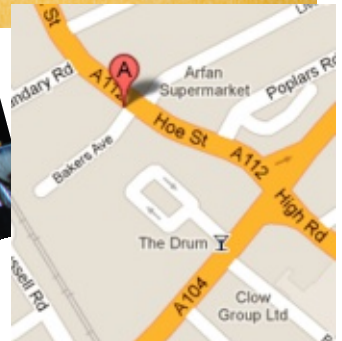
Jonathan Brind, a Leyton based video maker, tells Clarence's story at the same time as lifting the lid on some the insanities of the art world.
